

# Dreamweaver Web Design Project

You will be creating a website that is 3-4 pages in length including the homepage incorporating several Dreamweaver elements that you have learned in class. The site will be on a topic of your choice and needs to be **created in a professional fashion and organized**.

## Part 1 (10pts.) Due date: Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>

1. Provide your topic at top
2. Create a site map (storyboard) outlining the pages of your website in a Word document.  
--(Headings of pages, navigation, etc.)
3. Need to include the content that will be on your pages of your website - can be a bulleted list in phrases.  
**Also**, include which page the **table, spry accordion, spry tabbed and form** will be on & what info. will be in it

## Part 2 (The website - 110pts.) Due date: Tuesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>

1. Homepage (**named: index**) with a navigation bar that links all your pages together  
--(spry widget or develop rollovers in Fireworks or a template for the navigation bar).
2. Create a folder for your images and your CSS styles to keep them organized.  
--An external CSS style sheet needs to be created named **main\_styles.css**.
3. Create your own content for your pages  
--You may use the Internet for some of the content, but the **websites will need to be cited**.
4. Include approximately 10-15 images. A majority need to be your own images.  
If you use images from the Internet that **needs to be cited** somewhere in your website.
5. A table with at least 3 rows and 3 columns of information and make it look **visually appealing** with borders; cell alignment; maybe some color. You may include more than one table.
6. Create a spry accordion using at least 3 pictures **and** some text to describe them.  
Need to change panel colors and width across so it fits nicely on the page.
7. Create a spry tabbed panel (you will need to decide your content – at least 3-4 tabbed panels).  
Need to change panel colors and width across so it fits nicely on the page.
8. Include one form page that makes sense with your topic with at least 6 different buttons  
--(Ex. if you use 3 option buttons that is considered one set) and you will need 5 more buttons.  
**Form elements needed:** radio, checkboxes, list menu, text field, text area and submit button  
--Create a confirmation page for the submit button. Add text on the page, a picture and a background color and make it look nice and link it to the button.
9. Create an organized citations page for content and images used or cited at the bottom of each webpage.  
Link up all the sources to their respected websites

### 10. Other included criteria:

- a. Add 2 keywords that pertain to your website topic
- b. Add page titles on every page
- c. One outside link on **text** that opens in a new window
- d. One outside link on a **picture** that opens in a new window
- e. One horizontal line (change color and width)
- f. Two hotspots on one image map **or** one hotspot on two different image maps (linked to either a web page or two in your site or a couple of pages outside of your site – the links must pertain to your topic)
- g. One bulleted list including 4-5 bullets (Can be ordered or unordered)
- h. Create 2-3 anchors to sections of information on one of the webpages (put these together on one page)
- i. Background colors and font colors (be careful – make sure they are professional looking)

### Reminders:

1. Use `_blank` to have your pages open in new windows and links.  
--If you are using a template you do not have to worry about this for your pages.
2. Everything needs to work so **test everything** in Google Chrome.
